MINUTES of the Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Root Creek Water District (RCWD) held at 9:30 a.m., Wednesday, February 18, 2009, at the offices of Baker, Manock & Jensen, located at 5260 N. Palm Avenue, Fourth Floor, Fresno, California.

1. MINUTES

President Pierre asked if there were any corrections to the Minutes of the meeting held on June 5, 2008. Manager Provost indicated that he was not included under Others Present and requested that this be corrected. Upon motion by Director Coulthard, seconded by Director Jensen, the Minutes were approved with the requested correction.

2. BOARD OF DIRECTORS VACANCIES

President Pierre presented the resignation of Director Bascou, effective February 18, 2009, as the Grove Land Programs no longer own property within the District. President Pierre also presented the nomination of Timothy Jones, Member Manager of San Joaquin River Ranch, new owners of the Grove Land Programs' properties, as successor to the position held by Mr. Bascou and to complete the term which expires January 1, 2010. The Board unanimously adopted

Resolution 2009-01 appointing Timothy Jones to serve on the District's Board of Directors and requesting the Madera County Board of Supervisors affirm this appointment as soon as possible.

President Pierre then presented the resignation of Director Blunck, as Mr. Blunck is no longer an employee of a landowner within the District. President Pierre presented the request of Castle & Cooke to have Laura Whitaker fill the vacancy left by Mr.Blunck's resignation and to complete the term which expires January 1, 2010. The Board unanimously adopted

Resolution 2009-02 appointing Laura Whitaker to serve on the District's Board of Directors and requesting the Madera County Board of Supervisors affirm this appointment as soon as possible.

3. RESIGNATION OF TREASURER, ASSESSOR, TAX COLLECTOR

President Pierre reported that Jim Burkhart has retired and there is a need to fill his position of Treasurer, Assessor, Tax Collector. He suggested that Deborah Messer, who has been doing the Treasurer, Assessor, Tax Collector work for several year be appointed as Mr. Burkhart's replacement. Upon motion of Director Jensen, seconded by Director Cobb, Deborah Messer was unanimously appointed as Treasurer, Assessor, Tax Collector for the District.

4. TREASURER'S REPORT

Upon motion by Director Coulthard, seconded by Director Jensen, the Board approved the Treasurer's Report and placed it on file, ratified bills paid from June 5, 2008 thru present, and approved payment of accounts payable.

5. DISTRICT CHECKING ACCOUNT

President Pierre informed the Board of the need to update the District's checking account authorized signators. Currently the signators are Directors Cobb, Jensen and Pierre, and checks require two signatures. In the event, however, that two of these signators are not available, it presents a problem. Upon motion by Director Jensen, seconded by Director Cobb, the Board unanimously voted to add Directors Jones and Coulthard as authorized signators on the District's checking account.

6. CHANGE IN LOCATION OF DISTRICT OFFICE

President Pierre reported that Deborah Messer is no longer employed by S & J Ranch. She is now working for Rodger Jensen and all District files have been moved to that office. Deborah is continuing to do the District accounting and administrative work. Upon motion by Director Jones, seconded by Director Coulthard, the Board unanimously adopted

Resolution 2009-03 to change the official location of the District's office to 1396 W. Herndon Avenue, Suite 108, Fresno, California 93711. The District's new office phone and fax numbers are (559) 435-6403 and (559) 435-1603, respectively.

7. ACWA REGION 6 REPORT AND UPCOMING SPRING CONFERENCE

President Pierre gave a report on ACWA Region 6. He stated that the committee doesn't meet often, however they do put together events upon occasion. There will be a joint meeting with Region 7 committee on March 13, in Visalia. This will be a water forum with water and legislative representatives attending.

President Pierre also informed the Board of the upcoming ACWA Spring Conference, May 19 thru 22, 2009, in Sacramento. He stated that he attended last year and the cost to the District was approximately \$1500. He inquired of the Board if they felt it was beneficial to the District that he attend. Counsel Campbell stated that it is most beneficial to the District to have this exposure and the networking. President Pierre talked about networking at the Conference and that he is learning about being an M & I server. It has been good exposure for him. Upon motion by Director Jensen, seconded by Director Coulthard, the Board unanimously voted to have President Pierre attend the ACWA Spring Conference.

8. MADERA COUNTY WATER ADVISORY COMMISSION

President Pierre gave a report on the Madera County Water Advisory Commission. He stated that the meetings he has attended have been mostly regarding governance. The Commission has the power to recommend County ordinances which can affect the District. He stated that the State requires a Regional Water Management Group (RWMG) to govern the implementation of the Integrated Regional Water Management Plan. The RWMG must consist of at least three (3) public agencies. At least two of those must have authority for water management. The RWMG formation committee, in which President Pierre is a member, is in the process of developing a governance MOU between the public agencies and other potential participants. Grant applications for water infrastructure will be processed through the RWMG. The Root Creek Water District turnout and pipeline project is currently one of the projects in the County Integrated Regional Water Management Plan. There is also a possibility of getting some grant monies for the pipeline from the stimulus package, however, more information on that will be available shortly. The validity of the Commission was challenged by the Grand Jury. The Board of Supervisors went through the process and verified that the appointees on the Commission are qualified. Once the draft MOU is approved by the RWMG formation committee it will be circulated for comment and input from the potential participating agencies including RCWD.

9. MADERA COUNTY FARM BUREAU WATER CONFERENCE

President Pierre reported that the District is once again a sponsor of the Madera County Farm Bureau Water Conference. The conference will be held on February 20, 2009, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m, at the State Center Community College. Reservations are not required, and it is open attendance. He distributed information to each one present.

10. VILLAGE OF GATEWAY UPDATE

Counsel gave an update regarding the status of the Village of Gateway project. He stated that easement agreements for offsite water supply wells and wastewater disposal have been renegotiated with the purchaser of the Grove Land Programs' properties. The project was approved on September 11, 2007, however, a lawsuit was filed. The lawsuit was settled with the county's blessing. The plaintiff didn't want a change in the Gateway project. The settlement was a payment of \$1 million, in 5 \$200,000 increments each January, to be given to the Rose Foundation. The Rose Foundation is located in the Bay Area and administers settlements for the benefit of the public. They will develop grant criteria for what money can be used for and a list of potential grantees. Root Creek Water District is on the list of potential grantees. There is an advisory committee to administer each fund in the Foundation. The advisory committee for this fund consists of Bart Bond, Martin McIntyre, Julia Berry, Tony Ward and Charles Levitt.

All permits are done and Gateway projection is moving forward on the environmental analysis on the water plan. A cultural survey has been completed by the Bureau and the State Historical Preservation office has reviewed and approved it. Although the biology is signed off,

it may be subject to update due to the lapse of time.

Counsel is still working on a water exchange agreement and hopes to have it to MID by the end of February. The goal is to have all work done and Bureau approval by mid-summer 2009.

11. WESTSIDE MUTUAL WATER COMPANY AGREEMENT

Counsel presented the First Amendment to the Water Supply Agreement between the District and Westside Mutual Water Company. The Amendment modifies the 2009 payment schedule for the annual standby charge of \$676,242.00 (see attached), into quarterly payments with 8% interest. Upon motion by Director Jones, seconded by Director Jensen, the Board unanimously approved the First Amendment and authorized President Pierre to execute this Amendment, with the stipulation that Castle & Cooke deposit the monies to fund this Agreement on or before 20 days prior to the date due.

12. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, President Pierre adjourned the meeting at 11:33 a.m.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO WATER SUPPLY AGREEMENT (ROOT CREEK WATER DISTRICT – WESTSIDE MUTUAL WATER COMPANY, LLC)

This FIRST AMENDMENT TO WATER SUPPLY AGREEMENT (the "Amendment") is made effective this ___ day of February, 2009 (the "Effective Date"), by and between the ROOT CREEK WATER DISTRICT, a California water district ("RCWD") and WESTSIDE MUTUAL WATER COMPANY, LLC, a California limited liability company ("Westside").

RECITALS:

This Amendment is made with respect to the following facts and circumstances:

- A. RCWD and Westside are parties to that certain Water Supply Agreement dated November 1, 2006. All capitalized terms used herein shall have the meanings in the Water Supply Agreement, unless otherwise specified.
 - B. The Parties desire to amend certain payment provisions of the Water Supply Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. **Pricing.** In Section 3(b) of the Water Supply Agreement is hereby amended to read:
 - "The annual standby charge of \$ 676,242.00, for calendar year 2009 only shall be paid in quarterly principal installments of \$ 169,060.50 commencing with the January 31, 2009 payment with the remaining payments to be paid on April 30, 2009, June 30, 2009 and all remaining principal and unpaid interest shall be due and payable on or before September 30, 2009." The unpaid principal amount shall bear simple interest at eight percent (8%) per annum from January 31, 2009 until paid. All interest accrued to date shall be paid with each principal payment. There shall be no prepayment penalty.
- 2. **No Further Amendments**. Except as specifically modified by the Agreement, all terms and conditions of the Water Supply Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
