**NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS OF
PUBLIC HEARING
November 10, 2025 at 11:00 am
ON PROPOSED
2026 RATES, FEES, AND ASSESSMENTS**

Overview

The Root Creek Water District (District) sustainably manages surface water and groundwater resources to provide available water supply for agricultural and municipal customers within the District. The District imports and delivers surface water to agricultural customers and simultaneously provides potable water, stormwater, and sewer services to municipal customers. The District will consider adopting a rate schedule to recover the District's share of providing agricultural and municipal services.

The District completed a Municipal Rate Study Update in 2022, approved by the landowners in the District, to fairly determine the costs and rates for agricultural water service and municipal utility services. Connection Fees are reflective of the 2021 Connection Fee Update. The costs are found in Table 1., Table 2., Table 3., and Table 4., and are the estimated costs to provide services.
